The high altitude, remote and rugged areas of Ladakh are also home to the rare and elusive Snow Leopard with Hemis National Park (India's largest) and Zanskar Valley two of the best places to see these beautiful big cats.



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From Delhi, you'll take the short scenic flight to Leh, across spectacular Himalayan peaks. After a few days acclimatising and exploring the local area, visiting remote villages and ancient Buddhist monasteries, we travel on to stay at Rumbak Wildlife Lodge - your expedition base for the next few days, located deep in Snow Leopard territory and the perfect setting for your big cat wilderness adventure. The team of professional wildlife guides, spotters and trackers are highly experienced and will ensure you have the best experience and best opportunities to spot the Snow Leopards and other local animal and bird life.



From here you'll travel out into the surrounding high-altitude landscapes each day of your stay, with expert local wildlife trackers to spot the wonderful local wildlife and the highlight - the chance to see the rare and elusive Snow Leopard. Enjoy a fantastic winter wildlife expedition on this trip of a lifetime.

#### **Expected temperatures and conditions**

November to April is the perfect time to spot the Snow Leopard, also known locally as the 'grey ghost', and its mating season is Mid-February to End-March. Personal clothing - please note you will need a down jacket and warm comfortable clothing whilst in Ladakh. It's cold during the day so you'll need to wrap up. Nighttimes can be very cold but the lodge is very well insulated and heated and very comfortable. We will provide a full list of suggested clothing and equipment at the time of booking or on request prior to booking.

#### **Trip introduction**

Ladakh is a beautiful and remote borderland area of the Western Himalaya with amazing and sometimes starkly beautiful landscapes and wonderful peak views. It's a wonderful place for great trekking and tours during Spring, Summer and early Autumn months and is very much influenced by Tibetan culture. This winter trip focuses on spotting the rare and beautiful Snow Leopard in its natural habitat in the high and remote mountainous regions of Ladakh. Ladakh is at high altitude so on your first day arriving to Leh we recommend taking things very easy and rest and relax with no strenuous activity as you start to acclimatise. On your second day in Leh we'll introduce you to some of the key cultural and spiritual sites and highlights of Ladakh including visits to some of the local and very significant monasteries. The key focus of this Snow Leopard expedition is of course to give you the best chance possible to spot the rare Snow Leopards, often referred to as 'Grey Ghosts' in their natural habitat.

Located deep in the Trans-Himalayas of Ladakh, India, Rumbak Lodge is a wonderful mountainous hideaway, an undiscovered gem located on the periphery of Hemis National Park, deep within the heart of Snow Leopard territory. The lodge is around 40km from Leh airport and the drive is through narrow valleys along the Indus river. The lodge is set on a plateau overlooking the snow-capped mountain and the Rumbak river, with stunning 360-degree views of the mountains consisting of the Glacier valley towards the south east and the Tarbung Hill towards the south west - both of which are main spots for Snow Leopard sighting.

This unexplored area of Ladakh offers wildlife enthusiasts and adventurers a fantastic opportunity to spot the elusive Snow Leopard in its natural habitat with a rich tapestry of local wildlife that also includes rare and diverse bird and animal species such as Blue Sheep, Tibetan wolves, Tibetan Antelope, Asiatic Ibex, Wild Yak, Lynx, Red Fox, Himalayan Brown Bear, Pika and many more. The rich biodiversity is one of the reasons the Snow Leopards make their home here, close to rich hunting grounds.

It's not just the land that's rich in wildlife, the skies are too. Bird species include the Robin Accentor, Golden Eagle, Streaked Rose-Finch, Tickell's Leaf Warbler, Chukar, Tibetan Snow-Finch, Red-Billed Chough, Himalayan Snow-Cock, Common & Fork-Tailed Swift, Fire-fronted Serin, Twite and more are seen in this region. The high altitude, remote location and little to no

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light pollution means the night skies are spectacular too so enjoy the stargazing as an added bonus!

The team here are highly experienced conservationists, guides and trackers. During your time with them they'll share their knowledge and the mysteries of these mountains and wilderness areas, mixed with tales of their ancient culture. It truly is a very special and unique experience.

#### **Day to Day**

Day 01 Arrive Delhi

Welcome to Delhi! After completing immigration formalities, you'll be met by one of our local representatives for your transfer drive through the city to your hotel.

Delhi, the capital of India, is a cosmopolitan city with a fascinating blend of ancient and modern and a rich history stretching back thousands of years. Depending on your time of arrival, you'll have the option to take a guided tour of Old and New Delhi today or before your departure at the end of your trip. The rest of today is free for you to rest and relax and enjoy your hotel. Relax by the pool, enjoy the luxury surroundings, dine in one of the restaurants and unwind after your flight.

You'll be staying at the luxurious 5-star hotel, The Imperial. The Imperial is an iconic heritage hotel, considered one of the finest heritage hotels in Delhi and in Asia. Relax overnight at the <a href="Imperial">Imperial</a> (Heritage Room). Meals included: none but plenty of great options to try locally or in your hotel.

Day 02 Fly Delhi to Leh (3500m)

This morning, you'll be picked up for the transfer to the airport for the short flight (1 hr 20 minutes) to Leh, the capital and gateway to Ladakh and the start of your amazing Snow Leopard adventure. Depending on flight times for your dates of travel, it may mean an early start but it's worth it for the spectacular flight over the snow-capped peaks of the Himalayas to reach Leh.

Ladakh is the highest plateau in India and the name itself means land of high passes. This is a beautiful, high and remote borderland area of the Western Himalaya with unmistakable Buddhist influence. Located in the northeastern corner of India and nestled between the world's two highest mountain ranges of the Himalaya and the Karakorum, this is a wonderfully remote wilderness region where you'll find soaring mountain peaks, high Himalayan passes, stark arid plains and ancient monasteries and settlements.

You'll be met on arrival for the transfer drive to Leh (3500m). The rest of today is to rest and relax and start to acclimatise to the higher altitudes and chillier temperatures. We'll also be getting prepared to begin our quest to spot the Snow leopard – the most elusive of the big cats. This evening enjoy a gentle, optional orientation walk around Leh and visit to the local bazaar.

Rest overnight at the 5-star hotel The Grand Dragon

Meals included: breakfast.

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Day 3 Visit Leh, Thiksey, Shey & Hemis monasteries (3657m)

Today is a full day to acclimatise before we travel higher and to explore the interesting sites in and around Leh.

After breakfast, it's a short drive of around 19km to reach Thiksey village and visit Thiksey Gompa (Monastery). Thiksey is one of the largest and architecturally most impressive Gompas in Ladakh. There are several temples here to explore and enjoy the exquisite images, stupas and wall paintings of Lord Buddha. From Thiksey we drive on to nearby Shey village where you'll be able to visit Shey Palace and Gompa. Situated on a hillside 15 kms upstream from Leh, this was once the residence of the royal family. According to tradition, it was the seat of power in pre-Tibetan times. Here you'll see the impressive 7.5 m high copper statue of Buddha, plated with gold and the largest of its kind. After time to explore, we continue the drive to reach Hemis monastery, one of the most famous monasteries of Ladakh.

Hemis Gompa is the wealthiest, best known and largest monastery of Ladakh and is also the site of the large annual summer festival. popularity stems from the major annual festival, held to honour Guru Padma Sambhava's birth anniversary. Hemis also has the largest Thangka in Ladakh (a thangka is a large, hand painted pictorial religious scroll) which is unfurled only once every 12 years. Hemis monastery was built in 1630 during the reign of Singge Namgyal, an illustrious ruler of Ladakh.

This evening before returning to the hotel, we visit the magnificent Shanti Stupa, a large white domed Buddhist stupa. Rest and relax overnight at the 5 star hotel <u>The Grand Dragon</u>

Meals included: breakfast.

Day 04 Drive Leh to Rumbak Wildlife Lodge (3960m)

Now you've had time to acclimatise, today begins the quest for a sighting of the most elusive big cat - the magnificent Snow Leopard. After an early breakfast it's time to depart Leh for the drive of just over an hour. Nestled deep in the Ladakh Range, beyond medieval Tibetan Buddhist Monasteries and past ancient shepherding hamlets, the spectacular location of the camp and timeless Silk Road feel of the location strike the perfect balance between remote luxury and rugged adventure.

Arriving at the lodge, your transfer team will take you to check in, unless they receive word of an active wildlife sighting, in which case they will explore that opportunity first with check in later. After a tour of your accommodation and a briefing, it's time to set out in search of the Snow Leopards and other local wildlife with your tracking team.

The hotels we use are all very comfortable and good quality and we've selected 5 star luxury hotels in Delhi and Leh to make your trip as comfortable as possible during the winter months. At Rumbak Wildlife Lodge you'll stay in comfortable cottages. The lodge is set on a plateau overlooking the snow-capped mountain and the Rumbak river, with stunning 360-degree views of the mountains consisting of the Glacier valley towards the south east and the Tarbung Hill towards the south west - both of which are main spots for Snow Leopard sighting. On a good day you might even spot a Snow Leopard through the window!

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There are just 6 cottages, thoughtfully designed to blend in with the local surroundings using local materials, with amenities and facilities to make your stay as comfortable as possible in this remote high-altitude terrain. Rooms are well heated with floor heating and insulated roofs to traditional wood stoves and double-glazed windows for sufficient insulation and heat to keep the cold out. Heating blankets, and hot and cold water in the bathrooms ensure that you can freshen up comfortably after long eventful days.

Rest and relax overnight at Rumbak Lodge.

Meal included: Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 05 to 07 Rumbak Wildlife Lodge – full days Snow Leopard expedition tracking

You'll spend today and the next few days tracking wildlife through the valley and surrounding landscapes with your expert local trackers and guides. Snow leopards are most active at dawn and dusk and the spotters leave camp at dawn to visit various points in different valleys. They scan the ridge-lines and slopes for wildlife, reporting any sightings back to the lodge. The trackers and spotters work through the day, carefully scanning for wildlife and looking for signs. If a Snow Leopard is seen, you'll head to the closest vantage point by vehicle or walking, depending on the spotter's location. The rare and beautiful Snow Leopards are the highlight of this trip and a chance to see them in their natural habitat is the memory of a lifetime. You'll also have the chance to spot other local wildlife such as Lynx, Wolves, Golden Eagles, Blue Sheep, Himalayan Griffon Vultures, Ibex and many more. As well as wildlife spotting, you'll meet local people and learn about their culture and traditions and how they work to support conservation efforts to protect the Snow Leopards. During you time outside, meals, coffee, tea, snacks, all keep arriving from the lodge for as long as guests are at a sighting. You will also get opportunities to visit local homes and villages as well and talk with the people who live in this remote and beautiful region. These visits are an important way to understand what life is like here and how essential the local communities are to conservation. Daily guided wildlife tracking may include driving, walking, hiking, patiently watching and waiting or a mix of all.

Rest and relax overnight at <u>Rumbak Lodge</u>.

Meal included: Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 08 Drive Rumbak to Leh, fly to Delhi

After spending four days in search of the Snow Leopards, also known as the "ghost of the mountains", it's time to head back to Leh to board your flight to Delhi. The flights depart around midday so you'll be back in Delhi by mid-afternoon with the rest of your day to rest and relax, explore and perhaps do some local shopping or enjoy an optional guided tour of Old and New Delhi (available on request, please contact us for details).

You'll be met on arrival to Delhi for the short transfer drive to your hotel in nearby Aerocity, a convenient location for the airport and for a short return drive tomorrow for your departure home/onwards.

Relax overnight is at the five star <u>JW Marriott Aerocity</u> (Deluxe Room), close to the embassies and the international airport. Please note if you prefer to stay in the heart of Delhi or would like

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to add some additional days to your itinerary, for example to add a few days safari, trekking, tour or retreat after your Snow Leopard expedition. contact us for details and we'll be happy to share ideas and suggestions.

Day 09 Depart Delhi

This morning you'll be picked up for the short transfer drive to the International Airport for your flight home/onwards or to begin any additional extension trips you may have requested (available on request).

#### Our trip grading system

#### **Moderate to Challenging**

This trip is graded moderate to challenging. It is at high altitude so activity can feel more challenging especially after first arriving. Our itineraries all include appropriate acclimatisation days and the first day in Leh we don't plan any activity and advise you to rest and relax. There will be some easy to moderate walking involved and also sitting and waiting and viewing the wildlife through high quality optics, as part of this wildlife expedition. You don't need to be super fit but a reasonable level of fitness and ability to walk unaided is required.

## Trip altitude

Important - please be aware that this trip involves travel and some walking at altitude. All our itineraries are carefully designed to optimise acclimatisation to high altitudes, however participants on this trek are likely to experience some symptoms of being at altitude. The detailed trip information we provide when you book your holiday includes comprehensive advice on safe travel at altitude and all our guides are experienced and professional in recognising and managing symptoms of altitude, in addition to all our trips incorporating gradual ascents and rest and acclimatisation days. If you would like further information or advice on travel at altitude prior to booking, please contact our office to speak to an experienced member of our team.
